PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

National teams of the following countries will participate in the International U20 Competition: Czech Republic (CZE) - Hungary (HUN) - Poland (POL) and Slovakia (SVK)

PARTICIPANTS

Athletes born in 2004 and 2005 are eligible to compete. Number of athletes per country for each individual event is 2 and 1 relay. The number of team members is limited to 84 persons



for each participating country, counting athletes, coaches and team officials.

100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m, 5000 m, 110 m Hurdles (99/13,72-9,14), 400 m Hurdles (91,4/45-35-45), 3000 m Steeplechase, High Jump, Pole Vault, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put (6 kg), Discus Throw (1.75 kg), Hammer Throw (6 kg), Javelin Throw (800 g), 4x100 m, 4x400 m, 10 000m Race Walking

Junior Women (2004 in 2005)

100 m, 200 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m, 3000 m, 100 m Hurdles (84/13-8.50), 400 m Hurdles (76.2/45-35-45), 3000 m Steeplechase, High Jump, Pole Vault, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put (4 kg), Discus Throw (1 kg), Javelin Throw (600 g), Hammer Throw (4 kg), 4x100 m, 4x400 m, 10 000m Race Walking

RAISING OF THE BAR

High Jump - men: 180-185-190-193-196-199-202-205-208 ... + 2cm

High Jump - women: 145-150-155-160-165-170-173-176-179-182 ... + 2cm

Pole Vault - men: 360-380-400-410 + 10cm – 500 + 5cm

Pole Vault - women: 220-240-260-280-300-310 + 10cm - 380 + 5cm

The proposed starting heights will be confirmed at the Technical Meeting based on the participating countries final entries.

In the individual events the following scoring method is applied: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point.

In the relays the following scoring method is applied: 9, 6, 4 and 2 points.

CALL ROOM

Competitors present themselves before each start in the call room, which is located in the stadium tribune (ground floor), from where they will be taken to the competition sectors.

AWARD CEREMONIES

In each event the first 3 individuals will receive medals and diplomas.

In the team competition each participating country will receive a trophy.

DRESSING ROOM

Dressing rooms will be available in the premises of the warm-up stadium. The organizer is not responsible for things left in the dressing room, on the stands and in the stadium.

MEDICAL SERVICE

Medical service will be available in the stadium and warm-up area premises throughout the event.

PROTESTS

Protests related to the results, or which arose during the competition in a certain discipline, must be submitted orally to the head referee of the discipline immediately, no later than 30 minutes after the official announcement of the results of the given discipline on the scoreboard (Rule No. 8 of the Technical Rules of World Athletics).

An appeal against the decision of the head judge of the discipline can be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the official notification of the decision of the head judge of the discipline (Rule No. 8 of the Technical Rules of World Athletics).

The appeal, together with a deposit of €50, is submitted to the head referee of the competition, and the final decision is made by a jury.

The jury consists of the following competition officials:

- technical delegate (appointed by the SAZ Sports and Technical Commission),
- referee instructor (appointed by the SAZ Referee Commission),
- chief of referee, if he did not rule on the oral protest in the first stage of the protest procedure according to Rule No. 8 of the SA Technical Rules. In other cases, one of the other head judges is a member of the jury.

If one of these officials (jury) is not present or appointed, he will complete or the composition of the jury is determined by the competition director. When composing the jury, the principle must be observed that the members of the jury must be referees with referee qualifications at the national level, they must not decide on a protest in the first stage of the protest procedure according to rule No. 8 of the WA Technical Rules, and they should be from three different athletic divisions.



TECHNICAL NOTES

- a) All competitors selected by the competent doping control body are obliged to submit to a doping control. SAF is obliged to ensure the conditions for this inspection according to the relevant instructions.
- b) Competitors may warm up during the competition only in the warm-up stadium and areas outside the main stadium (except the pole vault and high jump).
- c) During the competition, it is forbidden to use electrically, technically or otherwise powered devices and instruments causing excessive noise (whistles, pressurized sound sprays, megaphones, etc.) in the entire sports area, including the stands.
- d) Only competitors, designated officials and referees have access to the competition venue. Teams officials enter is strictly forbidden.

FINAL NOTES

- a) Athletes compete according to the rules of World Athletics and according to these propositions.
- b) All athletes start at their own risk.
- c) The placement of athletes in individual runs, including the drawing of lanes, the determination of the order at the start and the progression key is determined by the technical delegate.
- d) The organizer of the competition reserves the right to change the timetable, has the right, after agreement with the technical delegate, not to allow an athlete to start, if his start would affect the technical organization of the competition.

Each participating country has to send an entry (filled out excel document sent with this information note). Entry has to be sent to e-mail addresses: domeny@atletika.sk and office@atletika.sk until June 19th 2023.
