Running Course

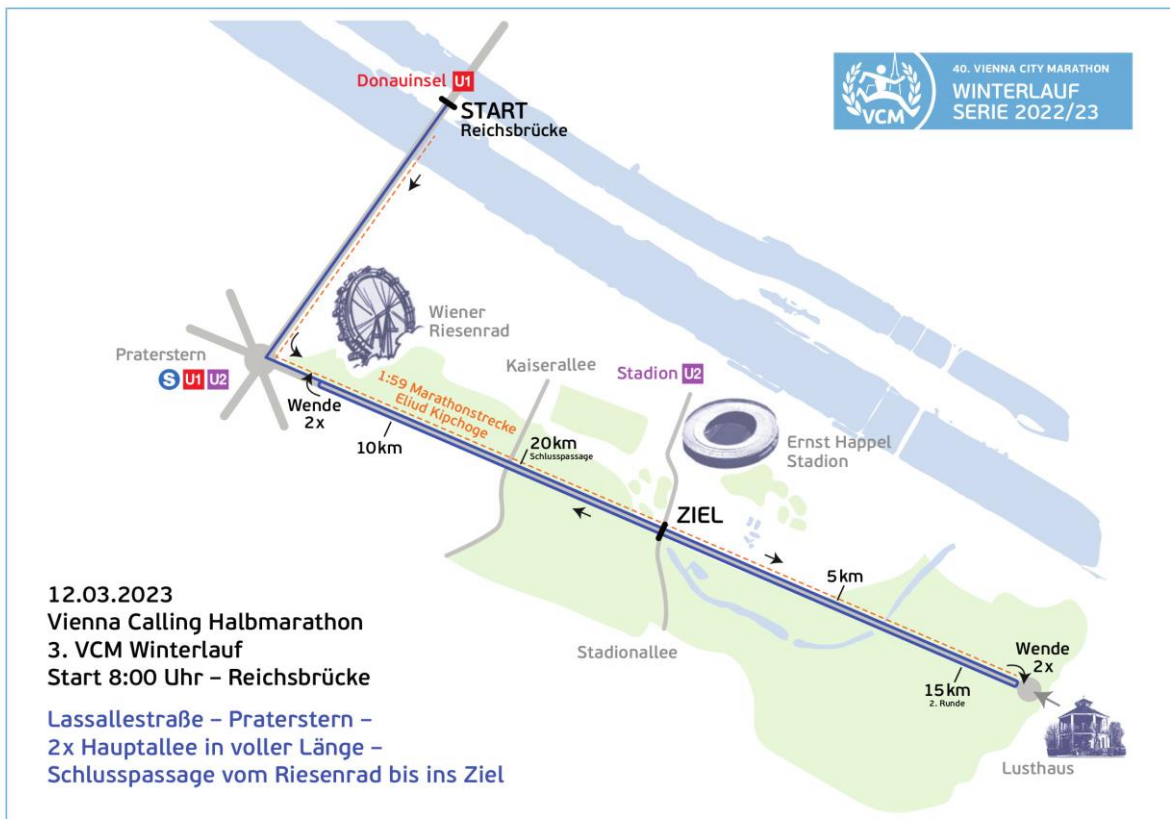
12 March 2023, Vienna Calling Half Marathon

Start: 8:00 am, Reichsbrücke

Finish: Prater Hauptallee, Stadionbadparkplatz - "Kipchoge finish"

Course: Reichsbrücke > Lassallestraße > Praterstern > Prater Hauptallee > Lusthaus > Riesenrad > Lusthaus > Riesenrad > Finish

Cut off: 10:45 am



Starting area: [Reichsbrücke – directly above the Danube island](#)

The starting area on the Reichsbrücke can be reached publicly by underground U1 (station Donauinsel), on foot or by bike via the footpath/cycle path below the Reichsbrücke.

Access to the Reichsbrücke is from the Danube Island via the south ramp. There is no access by car and no stopping or parking facilities on the Danube Island and/or the Reichsbrücke ramp south. Please allow sufficient time for your journey to the start.
